RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW JAIL AND SHERIFF'S ACCOMMODATIONS FOR WORCESTER COUNTY.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and two persons to be ap-
5 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of
7 current house document numbered 443, relative to providing
8 for the construction of a new jail and sheriff's accommodations
9 for Worcester county.

10 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state
11 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
12 and without the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical
13 and other services and expenses such sums as may be appro-
14 priated therefor. Said commission shall report to the general
15 court the results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
16 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary
17 to carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with
18 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the fourth
19 Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and sixty.
