AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF KATHERINE M. McNAMARA, A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to
2 the contrary, the city of Cambridge is hereby authorized and
3 directed to increase the retirement allowance of Katherine M.
4 McNamara, a former employee thereof, by the sum of one hun-
5 dred thirty-seven dollars and fifty-two cents annually, said in-
6 crease to be retroactive to December twenty-third, nineteen
7 hundred and fifty-four.
