Whereas, The House of Representatives learns with sorrow of the death of Samuel H. Wragg, who served with great distinction as a member of the House of Representatives from 1919 to 1924 and as a member of the Senate from 1924 to 1938, serving as its President for the years 1937-1938; and

Whereas, At the time of his death Samuel H. Wragg was serving with great distinction as High Sheriff of Norfolk County; and

Whereas, During his long and distinguished career in public life he was respected by those with whom he came in contact; and

Whereas, The passing of this public-spirited citizen is an irreparable loss to his community and the commonwealth; therefore be it

Resolved, That the House of Representatives hereby expresses its regrets and extends its deepest sympathy to the family of the deceased; and be it further
