RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO CERTAIN WATERWAY ACTIVITIES.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to make an investigation and study of the
3 subject matter of current house document numbered 143, pro-
4 viding for a study by a special commission relative to public
5 rights of ways along the coastline and the shores of the tidal
6 rivers of the commonwealth; of current house document num-
7 bered 996, providing for a study and survey of the land area of
8 Plum island within the city of Newburyport and the towns of
9 Newbury, Rowley and Ipswich for the purpose of defining and
10 establishing a master plan for the future utilization, develop-
11 ment and preservation of said Plum island; of current house
12 document numbered 999, establishing a special commission to
13 make an investigation and study relative to edible shellfish and
14 shellfish purification plants and a shellfish laboratory. Said
15 department shall report to the general court the results of its
16 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, to-
17 gether with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
18 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
19 house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of
20 January, nineteen hundred and sixty.
