1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established by  
2 chapter nineteen of the resolves of the current year, is hereby  
3 revived and continued for the purpose of continuing its investi-  
4 gation and study relative to providing for a suitable memorial  
5 in the new archives building to the late Edward J. Cronin, secre-  
6 tary of the commonwealth from nineteen hundred and forty-nine  
7 to nineteen hundred and fifty-eight. Said commission shall be  
8 provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may  
9 travel within and without the commonwealth and may expend  
10 for clerical and expert services and expenses as may be necessary  
11 or desirable to accomplish the purposes of this resolve such sums  
12 as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report  
13 to the general court the results of its investigation and study,  
14 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legis-  
15 lation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by  
16 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on  
17 or before the fourth Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred  
18 and sixty.
