AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SOUTHBRIDGE TO INCREASE THE PENSION OF OVILA MARTIN BY THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The amount of pension of Ovila Martin, retired  
2 police officer of the town of Southbridge police department, who  
3 is over the age of sixty and at the time of his retirement had  
4 over twenty years of creditable service, shall be increased by  
5 three hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon acceptance in the  
2 town of Southbridge, by a majority vote at a town meeting.
