AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE FOR WILLIAM ALDRICH, PROVISIONAL
POLICE OFFICER IN THE TOWN OF LEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. William Aldrich, a provisional police officer in
2 the town of Lee, shall be deemed to be permanently appointed
3 as police officer in accordance with chapter thirty-one of the
4 General Laws; provided, he passes a non-competitive qualifying
5 examination, which examination shall not include a physical ex-
6 amination or strength test, to be given by the division of civil
7 service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a
2 majority of the voters of the town of Lee present and voting
3 thereon at an annual town meeting.
