AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE PRESENT INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF POLICE CHIEF OF THE TOWN OF RAYNHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of the present incumbent of
2 the office of police chief in the town of Raynham shall be un-
3 limited during good behavior.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the
2 voters of the town of Raynham at the annual town meeting in
3 the year nineteen hundred and sixty in the form of the following
4 question which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used
5 for the election of town officers at said meeting: — "Shall an act
6 passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and
7 fifty-nine, entitled 'An Act relative to the tenure of office of the
8 present incumbent of the office of police chief in the town of
9 Raynham', be accepted?" If a majority of the votes in answer
10 to said question is in the affirmative, then this act shall there-
11 upon take full effect, but not otherwise.
