
By Mr. Tanerati of Springfield, petition of Armand N. Tanerati that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be authorized to issue temporary permits allowing certain semi-trailer units to travel on public ways. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE TEMPORARY PERMITS ALLOWING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES OR SEMI-TRAILER UNITS WHICH TOGETHER WITH THEIR LOADS HAVE A GROSS WEIGHT OF THIRTY-FIVE TONS TO TRAVEL ON A PUBLIC WAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 19B the following section: —
3 *Section 19C.* Notwithstanding any contrary provision of sec-
4 tion nineteen or of section sixty of chapter eighty-five, the reg-
5 istrar may issue permits, effective from the first day of December
6 to the first day of April of the following year, authorizing a con-
7 struction-type semi-trailer unit or motor vehicle having three
8 axles, or a semi-trailer unit or motor vehicle having three axles
9 while carrying liquid petroleum products, which vehicles, with
10 their loads, weigh not more than thirty-five tons, to travel on a
11 way while engaged in hauling construction materials or liquid
12 petroleum products; provided, that the gross weight of such a
13 vehicle, as operated, does not exceed the gross vehicle weight
14 rating as established by the original manufacturer of the chassis;
15 and provided, further, that the vehicle is duly registered in this
16 commonwealth for such weight.
