AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARIES FOR THE MAYOR  
AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the city  
2 charter, or of any special or general law, the salary of the mayor  
3 of the city of Chelsea shall be seventy-five hundred dollars per  
4 annum, and the salary of each alderman of said city one thousand  
5 dollars per annum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by  
2 a majority vote of the board of aldermen of said city subject to  
3 the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
