## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT PERMITTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SALARIES OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter  
2 ninety-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and fifty-two, as  
3 amended, and of section six A of chapter thirty-nine of the Gen-  
4 eral Laws and of any other special or general law to the contrary,  
5 the salaries of the members of the board of aldermen of the city  
6 of Springfield shall be fixed by the said board at an amount not  
7 in excess of one thousand dollars per annum and the salaries of  
8 the members of the city council of the said city shall be fixed by  
9 said council at an amount not in excess of eight hundred dollars  
10 per annum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by  
2 a majority vote of the members of the board of aldermen and  
3 the city council of said city subject to the provisions of its  
4 charter, but not otherwise.
