AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
2 present registrar of motor vehicles shall serve a full term of five
3 years from the date on which he was appointed.
