AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CLINTON TO INCREASE THE  
PENSION OF JOHN B. THOMPSON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The town of Clinton is hereby authorized to increase the  
2 amount of pension payable to John B. Thompson, a retired  
3 member of the fire department. Notwithstanding any provi-  
4 sions of law to the contrary, said John B. Thompson shall be  
5 paid a pension equal to the sum he would have received had  
6 he completed twenty years service in said town before his re-  
7 tirement.
