other general or special law to the contrary, the Middlesex county retirement system is hereby deemed to have accepted the provisions of said section twenty-two D of said chapter thirty-two upon the acceptance by the Middlesex county retirement board advisory council.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 292. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ROCKPORT TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND TO CONSTRUCT A WATER SUPPLY STANDPIPE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Rockport is hereby authorized to use a portion of a certain parcel of park land for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining a water supply standpipe. Said parcel being shown on a plan entitled "Plan of Pool Hill Tank Site, Rockport, Massachusetts, property of the town of Rockport" prepared by Donohoe & Parkhurst, Inc. and dated October 13, 1992.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 293. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3-1-1 of the charter of the town of Franklin, which is on file in the office of the archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section twelve of chapter forty-three B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out clause (d), as appearing in section 7 of chapter 705 of the acts of 1989, and inserting in place thereof the following clause:-

(d) Five members and one associate member of a planning board, to be elected from the town at large for three year overlapping terms of office.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
