AN ACT REVISING THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 2A thereof, as most recently amended by section
3 10 of chapter 730 of the acts of 1955, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following section: —

5 *Section 2A.* Upon the expiration of the term of office of a
6 commissioner of the civil service commission, his successor
7 shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent
8 of the council, for five years. The governor shall designate one
9 of the members as chairman. Not more than three members of
10 said commission shall be members of the same political party.
11 The chairman shall receive [thirty-five] **forty** dollars a day,
12 and each other commissioner shall receive [thirty] **thirty-five**
13 dollars a day, while attending meetings of the commission or
14 while performing any duties of his office required of him by the
15 chairman or by this chapter or chapter thirty-one, but in any
16 state fiscal year, not more than [six] **seven** thousand dollars
17 shall be paid to the chairman and not more than [five] **six**
18 thousand dollars shall be paid to any other commissioner. The
19 commissioners shall receive their traveling and other necessary
20 expenses incurred in attending such meetings.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH

IN RELATION TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

AS PASSED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in Senate Order numbered one for the session of the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two:

- Section 1. Chapter 1B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding to it the following sections, to-wit:

Upon the expiration of the term of office of a member of the Senate or House of Representatives, the committee of the next session shall be organized in accordance with the provisions of the constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth. The members of the committee shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for the first year of the session and thereafter for the members of the committee of the next session.
