RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF BERTHA CASSIDY.

1 *Resolved*, That in order to discharge a moral obligation of
2 the commonwealth, there be allowed and paid out of the
3 state treasury, subject to appropriation, to Bertha Cassidy of
4 Lawrence, widow of Henry Cassidy, a former uniformed mem-
5 ber of the division of state police in the department of public
6 safety, who was retired and subsequently died as a result of a
7 disability incurred while in the performance of his duty as a
8 member of the state police, an annuity of
9 dollars, payable in equal monthly instalments so long as she
10 remains unmarried.
