## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

### AN ACT

To provide for assisting Worthy Men and Women Graduates of Secondary Schools of the State to obtain a Higher Education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of assisting worthy  
2 young men and women graduates of secondary  
3 schools of the state to obtain higher education,  
4 the state will award competitive scholarships of  
5 the value of two hundred dollars per year for four  
6 years to enable selected students to attend any  
7 institution in the state of Massachusetts approved  
8 by the state board of education.

1 SECTION 2. Appointments to such scholarships  
2 shall be made by the state board of education

3 and the persons entitled to such appointments  
4 shall be determined by competitive examinations  
5 to be conducted under the supervision of the  
6 state board of education. Due notice of any  
7 examinations to be held under the provisions of  
8 this act shall be given in such manner as the  
9 state board of education may prescribe.

1 SECTION 3. One scholarship shall be awarded  
2 to each county. In any county where there is  
3 more than one senatorial district one scholarship  
4 shall be awarded to each senatorial district.

1 SECTION 4. The sum of eight thousand dollars  
2 or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby  
3 appropriated to the state board of education for  
4 the payment of the scholarships herein provided  
5 for.

1 SECTION 5. This act to become effective sixty  
2 days after its passage.
