To accompany the petition of M. A. O'Brien, Jr., to designate a Daniel Webster Highway. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

To designate a Daniel Webster Highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Whereas*, It is the custom of all states to honor
2 their distinguished dead by appropriate and en-
3 during monuments, and whereas the late Daniel
4 Webster represented our state in the congress of
5 the United States, as well as in the United States
6 senate with honor and distinction;

1 SECTION 1. Be it enacted that the great Massa-
2 chusetts highway, starting at the New Hampshire
3 state boundary and extending southerly through
4 Tyngsborough, Lowell, Chelmsford, Billerica, Bur-
5 lington, Woburn, Winchester, Arlington and Cam-
6 bridge is hereby given the name of the Daniel
7 Webster highway, and it is hereby authorized

8 that all cities and towns through which this high-
9 way passes shall direct all things necessary to
10 suitably mark and designate accordingly.

1 SECTION 2. It is further requested that memo-
2 rial trees be planted along this highway in loving
3 remembrance of those heroes who gave their lives
4 in the war with the German empire and Austria
5 in order that liberty might endure, and who were
6 residents of the county through which this high-
7 way extends.
