AN ACT

Prohibiting Certain Public Employees from Engaging
in Other Occupations for Hire.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
3 after section forty-four the following new sec-
4 tion: —

5 SECTION 44A. State, city or town employees,
6 including members of police and fire departments,
7 shall not engage during vacation periods or time
8 off duty in any occupation for hire other than
9 their regular public employment.
