To accompany the petition of William J. Francis that the retirement allowance of John Noonan be increased. Ways and Means.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

Relative to the Retirement Allowance of John Noonan, Retired Assistant Watchman of the State House.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Beginning with the first day of January,
2 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, the retire-
3 ment allowance or pension of John Noonan,
4 for many years an assistant watchman at the
5 state house, in the service of the commonwealth,
6 and retired under the General Laws, on April
7 three, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, shall
8 be based upon one half of the salary received by
9 him at the time of his retirement.
