To accompany the petition of the Boston Public School Employees' Veterans' Association relative to the retirement of certain veterans employed by the school committee of the city of Boston. Social Welfare.

AN ACT

Relative to the Retirement of Certain Veterans,
Employees of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The school committee of the city of Boston may
2 retire school janitors or custodians in its employ
3 under the provisions of sections fifty-six to sixty
4 of the General Laws, notwithstanding the provi-
5 sions of said sections, and shall determine the
6 regular compensation paid to such employees to
7 be such part or the whole of the amount paid to
8 such employee under the method now used in
9 determining the cost of janitors' or custodians'
10 services in the public school buildings as is re-
11 tained by a janitor or custodian for his own
12 services as fixed by the school committees.
