

SENATE No. 324

To accompany the petition of Dexter A. Snow and another relative to the construction of a certain highway near the Westfield State Sanatorium. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

Relative to the Construction by the Department of Public Works of a Certain Highway near the Westfield State Sanatorium.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The division of highways of the
2 department of public works may expend during
3 the current year the sum of thirty-five thousand
4 dollars for the construction of a concrete road
5 leading from the state highway, near the Westfield
6 state sanatorium under pass, northerly for a
7 distance of not more than three thousand feet;
8 and five thousand dollars of said sum shall be paid
9 by the city of Westfield. Upon the completion
10 of the highway the said city shall, within such

11 time and in such manner as the division of high-
12 ways may direct, pay its proportionate amount
13 into the state treasury.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of paying the
2 amount assessed on the city of Westfield, the said
3 city may borrow such sum as may be necessary,
4 not exceeding in the aggregate five thousand
5 dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor,
6 which shall bear on their face the words, City of
7 Westfield Highway Loan, Act of 1923, and shall
8 be payable in not more than one year from the
9 date of issue as it appears on the bonds or notes.
10 Indebtedness incurred under the provisions of this
11 act shall be in excess of the statutory limit, but
12 shall, except as herein provided, be subject to
13 chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the mayor and city council of
3 Westfield, provided that such acceptance occurs
4 prior to December thirty-first of the current year.
