


To accompany the petition of Richard J. Lane, chairman of the school committee of the city of Boston, relative to the transfer of certain lands in East Boston from the park department to the said committee. Metropolitan Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Three.

AN ACT

Relative to the transfer of Certain Lands in East Boston from the Park Department to the School Committee of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The William Amerena Play-
2 ground, formerly Cottage street playground,
3 and the Eagle Hill playground, formerly White
4 street reservoir, in the East Boston district of
5 the city of Boston shall hereafter be devoted to
6 school purposes and shall be under the control of
7 the school committee of the city of Boston, pro-
8 vided that the school committee appropriate the
9 sum of fifty thousand dollars to be transferred
10 to the park department to be used in acquiring
11 or developing other land for parks or playgrounds
12 in the East Boston district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the mayor and city council and the
3 school committee of the city of Boston.
