### RESOLVE

In Favor of the Widow of the Late Thomas Martin Joyce.

1 *Resolved*, That in consideration of his conscientious  
2 and meritorious services to the commonwealth in the  
3 course of his long and honorable career in the senate  
4 and house of representatives, and to the city of Boston  
5 which he efficiently served as a member of the city coun-  
6 cil, there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the  
7 commonwealth to the widow of Thomas Martin Joyce of  
8 Boston, who died while a member of the present house of  
9 representatives, the balance of the salary of fifteen hun-  
10 dred dollars to which he would have been entitled had he  
11 lived and served until the end of the current session. The  
12 state treasurer is hereby directed to make the payment  
13 hereby authorized out of the appropriation made in item  
14 three of the general appropriation act.
