An Act relative to Payment of Death Benefits by the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts Order Sons of Italy in America.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 Italy in America may pay death benefits to families
- 3 or dependents of deceased members as fixed by its
- 4 laws, not exceeding five hundred dollars.
