To accompany the petition of Edward J. Ruxton and others that cities and towns be authorized to appropriate money for the promotion of safety activities. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to the Appropriation of Money by Cities and Towns for the Promotion of Safety Activities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter forty of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section seven A, inserted
3 by chapter three hundred and sixty-five of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and thirty, and inserting in
5 place thereof the following: —

6 *Section 7A.* Cities and towns may appropriate
7 money for the purpose of conducting and main-
8 taining a specific program of safety activities de-
9 signed to promote street and highway safety, child
10 safety, home safety and fire prevention; and such
11 appropriations shall be expended under the direction
12 of the mayor in the city or the selectmen in a town.
