

To accompany the petition of Newland H. Holmes that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to remove the Nantasket Beach Hotel from the Nantasket Beach Reservation and make certain other improvements, — taken from the files of the preceding year. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for the Removal of the Nantasket Beach Hotel from the Nantasket Beach Reservation.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district com-
2 mission be hereby authorized and directed to
3 have removed from the Nantasket Beach reser-
4 vation the buildings constituting the Nantasket
5 Beach hotel and all appurtenances thereto and
6 structures used in connection therewith, and, if
7 necessary, to acquire by purchase or to take
8 under chapter seventy-nine or eighty A of the
9 General Laws the leasehold of the present lessee
10 thereof; to cause to be constructed on that part
11 of the reservation now occupied by said hotel
12 and its appurtenances such shelters, pavilions
13 and other structures and facilities as may be
14 necessary for the comfort and convenience of the

15 public; and to cause to be re-established the
16 public waiting room on the steamship wharf at
17 said reservation. All moneys realized by such
18 removal shall be paid into the metropolitan
19 parks expense fund.
