

SENATE No. 90

To accompany the petition of John G. Brackett for legislation relative to supplementary process after judgment in civil cases. Joint Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to Supplementary Process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section six of chapter two hun-
2 dred and twenty-four of the General Laws, as
3 appearing in section two of chapter three hun-
4 dred and thirty-four of the acts of nineteen hun-
5 dred and twenty-seven, is hereby amended by
6 striking out all after the word "employment" in
7 the eighth line down to and including the word
8 "Boston" in the eleventh line.

1 SECTION 2. Section thirty of chapter two hun-
2 dred and twenty-four of the General Laws, as
3 appearing in section two of chapter three hun-
4 dred and thirty-four of the acts of nineteen
5 hundred and twenty-seven, is hereby amended

6 by adding at the end thereof the following:—
7 The service upon any party of any summons or
8 notice under the provisions of this chapter may
9 be made by registered mail in accordance with
10 such rules or orders as the courts may establish.
