To accompany the petition of Arthur G. Sias, president, Municipal Lighting Association of Massachusetts, for legislation relative to deposits by customers of municipal lighting plants. Power and Light.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to Deposits by Customers of Municipal Lighting Plants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fifty-eight A of chapter one hundred
2 and sixty-four of the General Laws, as inserted
3 by chapter two hundred and sixty-nine of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, is
5 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof
6 the following:— Such deposits shall be held by
7 the manager of municipal lighting under the
8 direction of the mayor, selectmen or municipal
9 light board, if any, and his responsibility there-
10 for shall be included in the bond for the faithful
11 performance of his official duties required by
12 section fifty-six of this chapter.
