To accompany the petition of Lawrence J. MacNab and others for the reimbursement of Arthur W. Newcomb and other heirs of Samuel F. Newcomb for damage to certain property in the city of Quincy. Joint Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve in Favor of Arthur W. Newcomb and Others of Quincy.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging
2 the moral obligation of the commonwealth in
3 the premises, after an appropriation has been
4 made, there be allowed and paid out of the
5 treasury of the commonwealth, to Arthur W.
6 Newcomb and other heirs of Samuel F. New-
7 comb, late of Quincy, the sum of
8 dollars, as full compensation for all damage suf-
9 fered by them on account of the loss of their
10 interest in the business formerly carried on at
11 the property, consisting of the land, with build-
12 ings thereon, situated on East Howard street in
13 said Quincy, due to the taking of said property
14 by eminent domain by the commonwealth on
15 March twenty-first, nineteen hundred and seven-
16 teen.
