

To accompany the petition of Joseph A. Conway that the Department of Public Works be authorized to provide a channel and construct a landing and pier for ocean-going steamers at Buzzards Bay in the town of Bourne. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act providing for Construction of a Landing and Pier for Ocean-going Steamers and Dredging of a Channel at Buzzards Bay in the Town of Bourne by the Department of Public Works.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subject to an appropriation here-
2 after to be made the department of public works
3 is directed to forthwith make a survey and present
4 plans for bids for dredging a channel as near as
5 possible to spar buoy fifteen in Buzzards Bay
6 and to construct a landing pier for freight and
7 passengers landing from Sound steamers or other
8 steamers from Boston or New York and following
9 necessary appropriation to engage in said work
10 without delay.

1 SECTION 2. Said pier shall remain the prop-
2 erty of the commonwealth and shall be open to
3 through steamers between New York and Boston
4 and to other passenger or freight steamers for
5 landing purposes only.
