

SENATE No. 178

To accompany the petition of George A. Lawrence that he be compensated for damages sustained in consequence of an accident on a State highway. Joint Ways and Means.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve in favor of George A. Lawrence of Holyoke.

1 *Resolved*, That after an appropriation has been
2 made, and for the purpose of discharging in full
3 the obligation of the commonwealth in the prem-
4 ises, there be allowed and paid out of the treasury
5 of the commonwealth to George A. Lawrence of
6 Holyoke, a sum not exceeding
7 dollars, as compensation for personal injuries and
8 property damage sustained by the said Lawrence
9 in consequence of an accident occurring in the city
10 of Holyoke on the state highway leading from
11 Northampton to Holyoke, January fifth, nineteen
12 hundred and twenty-six, said accident being due
13 to the faulty layout of said highway and the lack
14 of warning signals at the point where said accident
15 occurred.
