To accompany the petition of John P. Buckley that the use of special hackney stands and public hackney stands, so called, in the city of Boston be further regulated. Cities.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act further Regulating the Use of Special Hackney Stands and Public Hackney Stands, so-called, in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter three hundred and ninety-two of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty is hereby
3 amended by inserting after section eight the
4 following new section:—

5 *Section 8A.* Nothing in this act shall be
6 construed to prevent the use, at any time, for a
7 reasonable period, by a vehicle owned and/or
8 operated by any person other than one licensed
9 under section four, of that portion of any public
10 way designated under this act as a special hack-
11 ney stand or as a public hackney stand.
