The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act subjecting the Offices of Superintendent of Wires and City Engineer of the City of Revere to the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The offices of superintendent of
2 wires and city engineer of the city of Revere shall,
3 upon the effective date of this act, become sub-
4 ject to the civil service laws and rules and regula-
5 tions and the term of office of any incumbent
6 thereof shall be unlimited except that they, or
7 either of them, may be removed in accordance
8 with such laws and rules and regulations; but the
9 persons holding said offices, namely, superin-
10 tendent of wires and city engineer on said effective
11 date shall continue therein without taking a civil
12 service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by majority
3 vote of the municipal council of said city but not
4 otherwise.
