To accompany the petition of Charles P. Abbott that bowling in certain cities and towns on the Lord's Day be legalized. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act to legalize Sunday Bowling in Certain Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following new section: —

4 *Section 29.* In any city or town which accepts
5 this section, nothing in this chapter shall render
6 unlawful presence at or participation in the game
7 of bowling, between the hours of two and eleven,
8 post meridian, on the Lord's day.
