

SENATE No. 328

To accompany the petition of the Governor's Committee on Street and Highway Safety, by Howard Coonley, Chairman, and others, for the appointment of a special commission (including members of the General Court) to revise the laws relative to motor vehicles. Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Resolve providing for a Revision of the Laws relative to Motor Vehicles.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission
2 is hereby established, to consist of sen-
3 ators to be designated by the president of the
4 senate, representatives to be designated
5 by the speaker of the house of representatives,
6 and members to be appointed by the
7 governor, for the purpose of revising and codify-
8 ing the laws relating to motor vehicles, with
9 power to recommend such substantive changes
10 therein as may appear necessary. Said com-
11 mission shall be provided with quarters in the
12 state house, and may expend for clerical and
13 other assistance such sums as may be appropri-
14 ated. The commission shall report a revision
15 and codification of such laws to the general court
16 not later than the first Wednesday of December
17 in the current year.
