Bacon for legislation relative to the construction of certain parts of Centre Street in the city of Boston; the petition (with accompanying bill, House, No. 135) of George A. Gilman relative to the width at which Centre Street may be reconstructed in the Jamaica Plain and Roslindale sections of the city of Boston; and the petition (with accompanying bill, House, No. 237) of James M. Curley, mayor, for an amendment of the law relative to the reconstruction of Centre Street in the Jamaica Plain and Roslindale districts of the city of Boston, reports the accompanying bill (Senate, No. 331).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act further regulating the Reconstruction of a Part of Centre Street in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-
2 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
3 nine is hereby amended by striking out section one
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 *Section 1.* The board of street commissioners
6 of the city of Boston may, with the approval of the
7 mayor of said city, lay out, widen, extend, relocate
8 and reconstruct Centre street in said city from a
9 point at or near May street to a point at or near
10 South street.

1 SECTION 2. All sums of money which, prior to
2 the passage of this act, have been voted to be pro-
3 vided from taxes or other sources of revenue and
4 the proceeds of any securities which, prior to such
5 passage, have been authorized under the provi-
6 sions of section four of said chapter two hundred
7 and forty-eight, may be expended for the work
8 authorized by section one of said chapter, as

9 amended by this act, and the provisions of said
10 section four applicable to said Centre street shall
11 be available for the purposes of said section one,
12 as so amended.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter two hundred and forty-
2 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-
3 nine having been submitted to and accepted by
4 the city council of the city of Boston, in accord-
5 ance with the provisions of section five thereof,
6 this act in amendment of said chapter two hun-
7 dred and forty-eight shall take effect upon its
8 passage and without being further submitted to
9 the city council of said city.
