

SENATE No. 347

To accompany the petition of John P. Buckley that the city of Boston be authorized to reinstate Francis J. Riordan in the police department of said city. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act authorizing the Reinstatement of Francis J. Riordan in the Police Department of the City of Boston. .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Francis J. Riordan, who resigned
2 from the police department of the city of Boston
3 on the seventeenth day of March, nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-six, may be reinstated in
5 said department without further examination,
6 and, upon said reinstatement he shall be entitled
7 to the same pension and retirement rights as if
8 his term of service in said department had not
9 been interrupted by said resignation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its acceptance by vote of the city council of
3 said city, subject to the provisions of its charter;
4 provided such acceptance shall occur during the
5 current year.
