The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

Resolve providing for an Investigation relative to the Establishment of an Appropriate Memorial to commemorate the Virtues and Achievements of Major-General Clarence R. Edwards.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission,
2 to consist of five citizens of the commonwealth
3 to be appointed by the governor, of whom three
4 shall be members of the Yankee Division Vet-
5 erans Association, is hereby established for the
6 purpose of advising the general court as to the
7 character, form and location, whether on the
8 state house grounds or elsewhere in the city of
9 Boston, of memorial which should be erected to
10 commemorate the virtues and achievements of
11 the late Major-General Clarence R. Edwards,
12 and to afford lasting evidence of the affection
13 and esteem in which he is held by all the people
14 of the commonwealth. The commission may
15 expend for necessary assistance and expenses,
16 from such appropriation as may be made, sums
17 not exceeding, in the aggregate, two thousand
18 dollars, and shall file its recommendations with
19 the clerk of the senate on or before the first day
20 of May in the current year.
