

SENATE No. 468

To accompany the petition of Charles C. Warren that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to construct an extension to an existing sewer in the town of Arlington. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act providing for the Construction by the Metropolitan District Commission of an Extension to an Existing Sewer in the Town of Arlington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district com-
2 mission is hereby authorized to construct and
3 maintain an extension of the main sewer in the
4 valley of Mill or Sucker brook in the town of
5 Arlington, from its present terminus at Forest
6 street in said town to Park avenue in said town,
7 and for this purpose may exercise all the powers
8 conferred upon it by chapter ninety-two of the
9 General Laws relative to the construction, main-
10 tenance and operation of sewage disposal works.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of the construction au-
2 thorized by section one shall be paid out of the

3 unexpended balances remaining from the pro-
4 ceeds of loans issued under authority of chapter
5 one hundred and sixteen of the acts of nineteen
6 hundred and twenty-four and of chapter one
7 hundred and eighty-four of the acts of nineteen
8 hundred and twenty-seven, as amended by chap-
9 ter two hundred and eleven of the acts of nine-
10 teen hundred and twenty-eight and as affected
11 by chapter one hundred and eighty-eight of the
12 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and
13 not required for the purposes of said chapters or
14 of chapter two hundred and thirteen of the acts
15 of nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
