The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act relative to Salaries of Judges of Probate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and seven-
2 teen of the General Laws, as most recently
3 amended in section thirty-four by section one
4 of chapter three hundred and eighty of the acts
5 of nineteen hundred and twenty-six, is hereby
6 further amended by striking out said section
7 thirty-four and inserting in place thereof the
8 following: —

9 *Section 34.* The salaries of all judges of pro-
10 bate, both senior and junior, shall be paid by
11 the commonwealth and are hereby established
12 as follows: —

County.	Salary.
Nantucket and Dukes County	\$3,000
Barnstable, Franklin and Hampshire	5,000
Berkshire	5,500
Plymouth	6,000
Norfolk, Hampden and Bristol	7,000
Worcester and Essex	8,000
Middlesex	9,500
Suffolk	10,000

1 SECTION 2. The retirement allowances, under
 2 sections sixty-one and sixty-two of chapter thirty-
 3 two of the General Laws of judges of probate
 4 and insolvency appointed before July second,
 5 nineteen hundred and twenty-one shall be based
 6 on the salaries received by them on November
 7 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

1 SECTION 3. Section thirty-eight of said chap-
 2 ter two hundred and seventeen, as amended, is
 3 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on Jan-
 2 uary first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two.
