Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Public Works relative to the Improvement of a Highway in the Towns of Georgetown, Newbury and West Newbury and the City of Newburyport.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works  
2 be hereby authorized and directed to investigate  
3 relative to the necessity, expediency and cost of  
4 improving the highway running from George-  
5 town corner, so called, over North street in the  
6 town of Georgetown, through the towns of New-  
7 bury and West Newbury to the city of Newbury-  
8 port, a part of which highway is known as  
9 Scotland road, and to report to the general court  
10 by filing its recommendations, estimates of cost  
11 and drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
12 recommendations into effect, with the clerk of  
13 the senate not later than the first Wednesday of  
14 December in the current year.
