The Special Commission created under chapter 29 of the Resolves of 1931 to study revision of the State laws relative to co-operative banks, respectfully reports substantial progress in its work and asks that, because of delays through the special session of the Legislature and the technical nature of its work, it be granted an extension of the time of its study to not later than the first Wednesday in December, 1932, with such appropriation therefor as the General Court shall deem necessary.
