

To accompany the petition of James G. Moran that provision be made for printing and distributing maps showing the division of the Commonwealth into Congressional districts. Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

Resolve providing for Printing and Distributing Maps showing the Division of the Commonwealth into Congressional Districts.

1 *Resolved*, That there be printed, under the
2 direction of the secretary of the commonwealth,
3 five thousand copies of a map showing the divi-
4 sion of the commonwealth into congressional
5 districts, according to chapter four hundred and
6 thirty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred
7 and thirty-one; ten copies of said map to be
8 distributed to each member of the general court,
9 one copy each to the clerk of the senate, the
10 clerk of the house of representatives, the counsel
11 to the senate and the counsel to the house of
12 representatives; and the remaining copies to
13 be deposited in the office of the secretary of the
14 commonwealth for distribution by him in his
15 discretion. For the aforesaid purposes, a sum
16 not exceeding hundred dollars
17 may be expended from such appropriation as
18 may be made by the general court.
