Reed that provision be made for the construction and maintenance as a part of the State highway system of a new bridge over Weymouth Fore River between the city of Quincy and the town of Weymouth, report the accompanying resolve (Senate, No. 292).

Resolve providing for the Making and Preparation by the Department of Public Works of Surveys, Estimates, Plans and Specifications for the Construction of a New High Level Bridge over the Weymouth Fore River between the City of Quincy and the Town of Weymouth.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make and prepare
3 surveys, estimates of cost, plans and specifications for
4 the construction of a new high level bridge and ap-
5 proaches thereto over the river between the city of
6 Quincy and the town of Weymouth to replace a bridge
7 commonly known as the Weymouth Fore River
8 bridge, and may expend therefor from the highway
9 fund such sum, not exceeding seventy thousand dollars,
10 as may be hereafter appropriated. Said department
11 shall report to the general court a statement of the
12 estimated cost of the construction of said bridge and
13 approaches, together with drafts of legislation neces-
14 sary to provide for such construction, by filing the
15 same with the clerk of the senate on or before the
16 first Wednesday of December in the current year, and
17 shall, at the same time, file a copy thereof with the
18 budget commissioner.
