## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

---

An Act establishing the Salaries of the Present Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the Senate.

1    *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act  
2 would cause substantial inconvenience inasmuch  
3 as the compensation provided for would be de-  
4 layed beyond a reasonable time, therefore it is  
5 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary  
6 for the immediate preservation of the public  
7 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECTION 1. The salary of Irving N. Hayden as  
2 clerk of the senate shall be five thousand dollars,  
3 and the salary of Thomas A. Chadwick as assist-  
4 ant clerk of the senate shall be thirty-five hundred  
5 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The salaries provided for in this  
 2 act shall be allowed from items five and six,  
 3 respectively, of the general appropriation act of  
 4 the current year, and shall date from March  
 5 fourteenth in said year in each case.

The Commission of Government

An Act to establish the salaries of the President of the Senate and the Secretary of the Senate

Section 1. The salary of the President of the Senate shall be \$10,000 per annum, payable in twelve equal installments, and shall date from the first day of January in each year. The salary of the Secretary of the Senate shall be \$5,000 per annum, payable in twelve equal installments, and shall date from the first day of January in each year.

Section 2. The salaries provided for in this act shall be allowed from items five and six, respectively, of the general appropriation act of the current year, and shall date from March fourteenth in said year in each case.

Section 3. The salary of the President of the Senate shall be \$10,000 per annum, payable in twelve equal installments, and shall date from the first day of January in each year. The salary of the Secretary of the Senate shall be \$5,000 per annum, payable in twelve equal installments, and shall date from the first day of January in each year.
