Resolve reviving and continuing the Special Commission established to make a Survey and Revision of the Laws relating to Savings Banks.

1     *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission,  
2 established by chapter forty-one of the resolves  
3 of nineteen hundred and thirty-one for the  
4 purpose of making a survey and revision of the  
5 laws relating to savings banks, is hereby revived  
6 and continued, and the final report of said com-  
7 mission, together with drafts of legislation neces-  
8 sary to carry its recommendations into effect,  
9 shall be filed with the clerk of the house of  
10 representatives on or before the first Wednesday  
11 of December in the current year. For the  
12 purposes of this resolve, said commission may  
13 expend such sum, not exceeding thirteen hundred  
14 dollars, as may be hereafter appropriated therefor,  
15 in addition to the unexpended balance of the  
16 amount appropriated by item thirty-six J of  
17 chapter four hundred and sixty of the acts of  
18 nineteen hundred and thirty-one.
