The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to borrow and to raise by Taxation Money for Hospital Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of erecting additional
2 buildings for the Boston city hospital, for remodeling
3 existing buildings of said hospital and for the pur-
4 chase of additional property for the purposes of said
5 hospital, or for any of said purposes, the city of
6 Boston may borrow, outside the statutory limit of
7 indebtedness, from time to time within a period of
8 five years from the passage of this act, such sums as
9 may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate,
10 five hundred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds
11 or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the
12 words, Boston City Hospital Loan, Act of 1932.
13 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate
14 loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than
15 fifteen years from their dates, but no issue shall be

16 authorized under this act unless a sum equal to each
17 such authorized issue is voted for the same purpose
18 to be raised from taxes or other sources of revenue
19 or from the proceeds of indebtedness incurred within
20 the statutory limit of indebtedness. Except as
21 herein provided, indebtedness incurred under this
22 act shall be subject to the laws relative to the in-
23 currence of debt by said city.

1 SECTION 2. The said city, for the purpose of raising
2 any sum voted to be raised by taxation as authorized
3 by section one may levy taxes outside the tax limit
4 for general municipal purposes to an amount not
5 exceeding the amount so voted.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter, but not otherwise.
