An Act authorizing the Town of Plymouth to vote to revoke its Acceptance of the Law authorizing the Establishment of a Two Platoon System, so-called, in its Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth may, at a
2 town meeting called for the purpose, vote to
3 revoke its acceptance of section fifty-nine of
4 chapter forty-eight of the General Laws.

5 If the town so votes to revoke such acceptance,
6 then the town shall not be required to maintain
7 two platoons in its fire department. Nothing
8 herein contained shall prevent the town from
9 hereafter accepting the provisions of said section
10 fifty-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
