## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act authorizing the Metropolitan District Commission to construct and maintain a Comfort Station near the Entrance to the Wachusett Dam on Boylston Street in the Town of Clinton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission  
2 is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a  
3 comfort station near the entrance to the Wachusett  
4 dam on Boylston street in the town of Clinton,  
5 together with the necessary sewer connections. Sub-  
6 ject to appropriation, the commission may expend for  
7 the said purposes a sum not exceeding ten thousand  
8 dollars, the same, together with costs of maintenance,  
9 to be assessed upon the cities and towns constituting  
10 the metropolitan water district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
